

# THIS MODULAR MAT OFFERS MANY OPTIONS FOR USAGE & TO REMOVE FROM WATER

**BEFORE PLACING MATS IN THE WATER** – Lay them on a solid surface such as the lawn. Zip every other top/bottom zipper so the mats are bi-folded in advanced.

## **LOGOS FACE UP & FULL LENGTH BOTTOM DRAINAGE PORT FACES DOWN**

*\*\*\*With the full length drainage port on the bottom, as mats are lifted up and out of the water, the water will automatically flow down towards the bottom drainage port or the side port if slightly tilted towards that area.*

## MAT REMOVAL OPTIONS

**INDIVIDUALLY or SMALL GROUPS** – Unzip each individual mat’s zipper from the other mats and lift out of the water or remove smaller groups of 3qty mats at a time as an example. This is great for very long mats, simply remove small quantities of mats at a time.

**BI-FOLDING MATS** – This can be done in the water or as the mats are being pulled from a boat or dock: Start at the anchor mat, unzip the top zipper, go to the next mat, unzip the bottom zipper facing the water, next mat unzip the top zipper and so forth.

Bi-fold the mats so the water will flow toward the bottom drainage port or tilt slightly towards the side drainage port and remove from the water.

**\*\*\*DO NOT SWIM UNDERNEATH THE MATS TO ZIP OR UNZIP THE BOTTOM ZIPPERS FACING THE WATER!**

Reach under the mat to zip or unzip the bottom zipper halfway or arm’s length. Swim around to the other side of the mat or have a partner at the other side pull the zipper the rest of the way open or closed. This can also be done by pulling the mats out of the water onto a dock or swim platform and unzipping them as they are pulled from the water.

\*Mats can be laid on even if not all top/ bottom zippers are zipped closed. To keep the mats stabilized, both top/bottom zippers must be zipped closed.

\*You can also place bi-folded mats in the water and zip all the top zippers only, Leaving the bottom zippers partially zipped. This allows the top of the mat to not flex. When done, unzip only two top zippers and mats will bi-fold again.

### Locking Zipper Head

The zipper pull will click and lock into place when it is flat, facing the rear of the zipper head. Zipper is unlocked if the zipper pull is vertical or laying towards the front of the zipper head.
